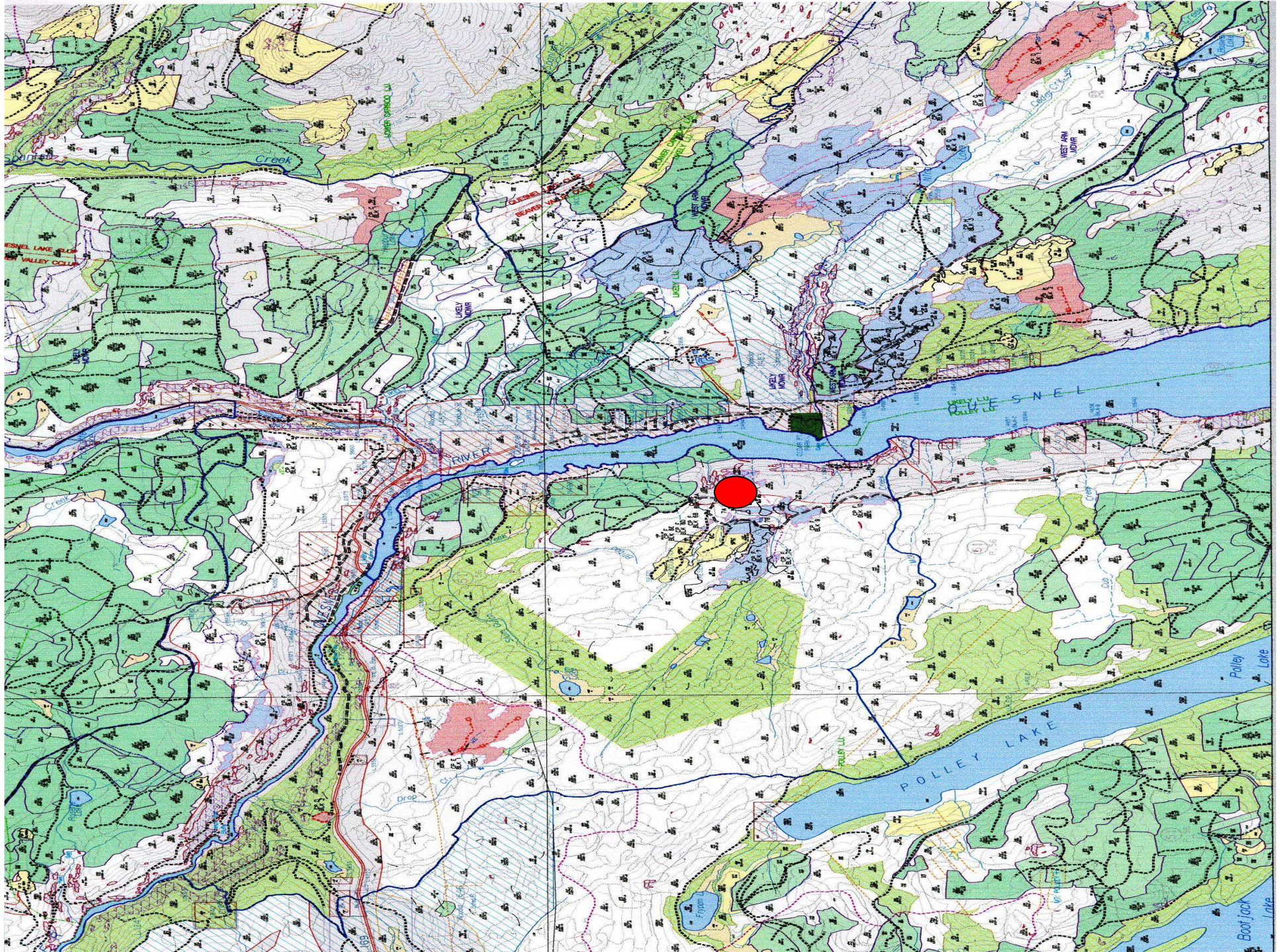


Blow Down

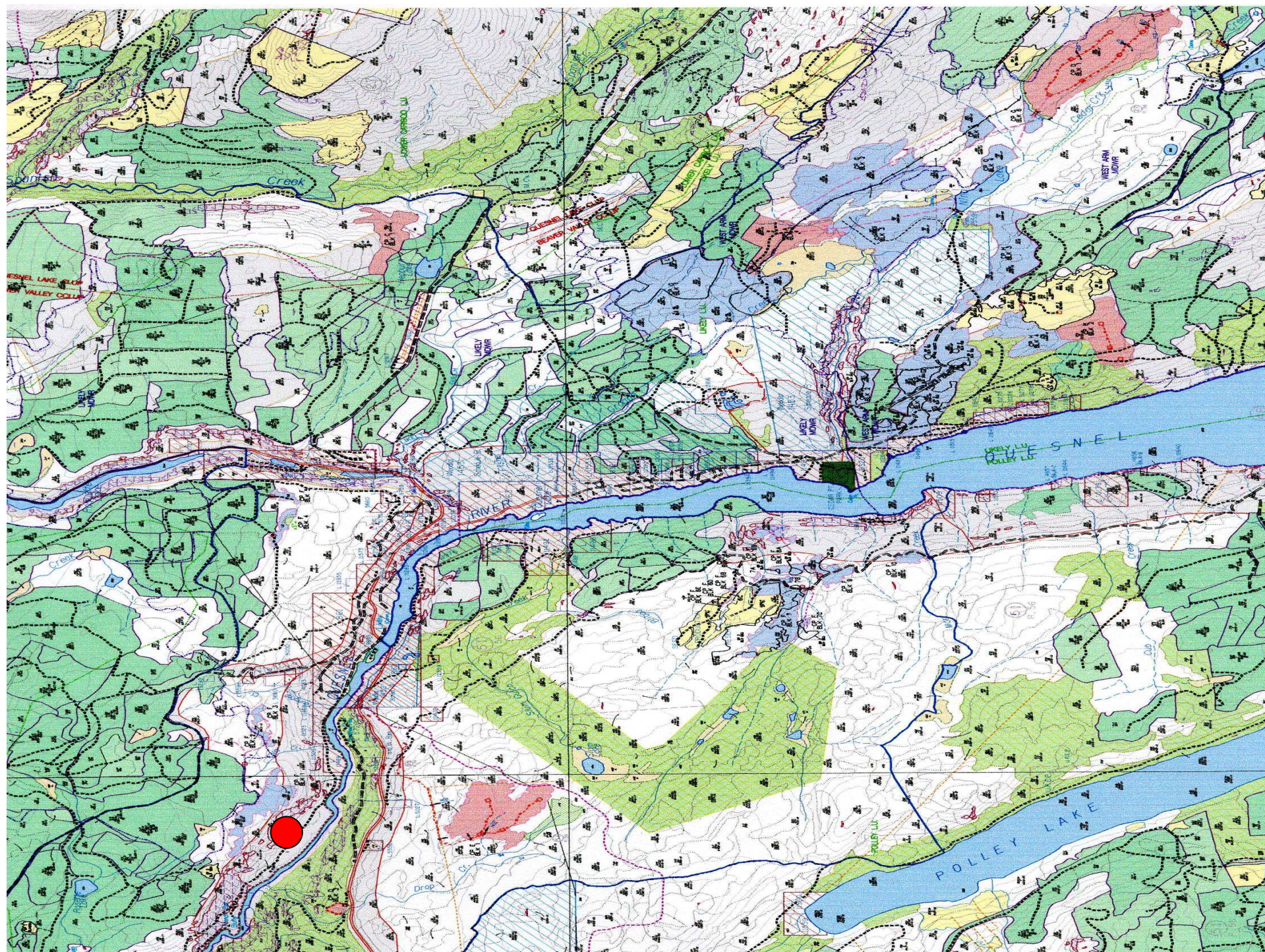
- Residual Fir blow down.

STOCKING SURVEYS



- We surveyed all single tree select harvested blks.
- Identified any openings that need to be planted.
- no openings were found.
- 460 ha. total

TREE PLANTING

- Out of town contractor
- 25% of crew are locals.
- 100,700 fir
- 90,000 pi
- 95,700 sp
- 286,400 total



DOUGLAS FIR TRAP TREE PROGRAM

06/07



- Fir Beetle is on the rise.
- 24 trap tree sites were felled in late June early July.
- Trees were then picked up in the fall.

DOUGLAS FIR TRAP TREE PROGRAM

07/08



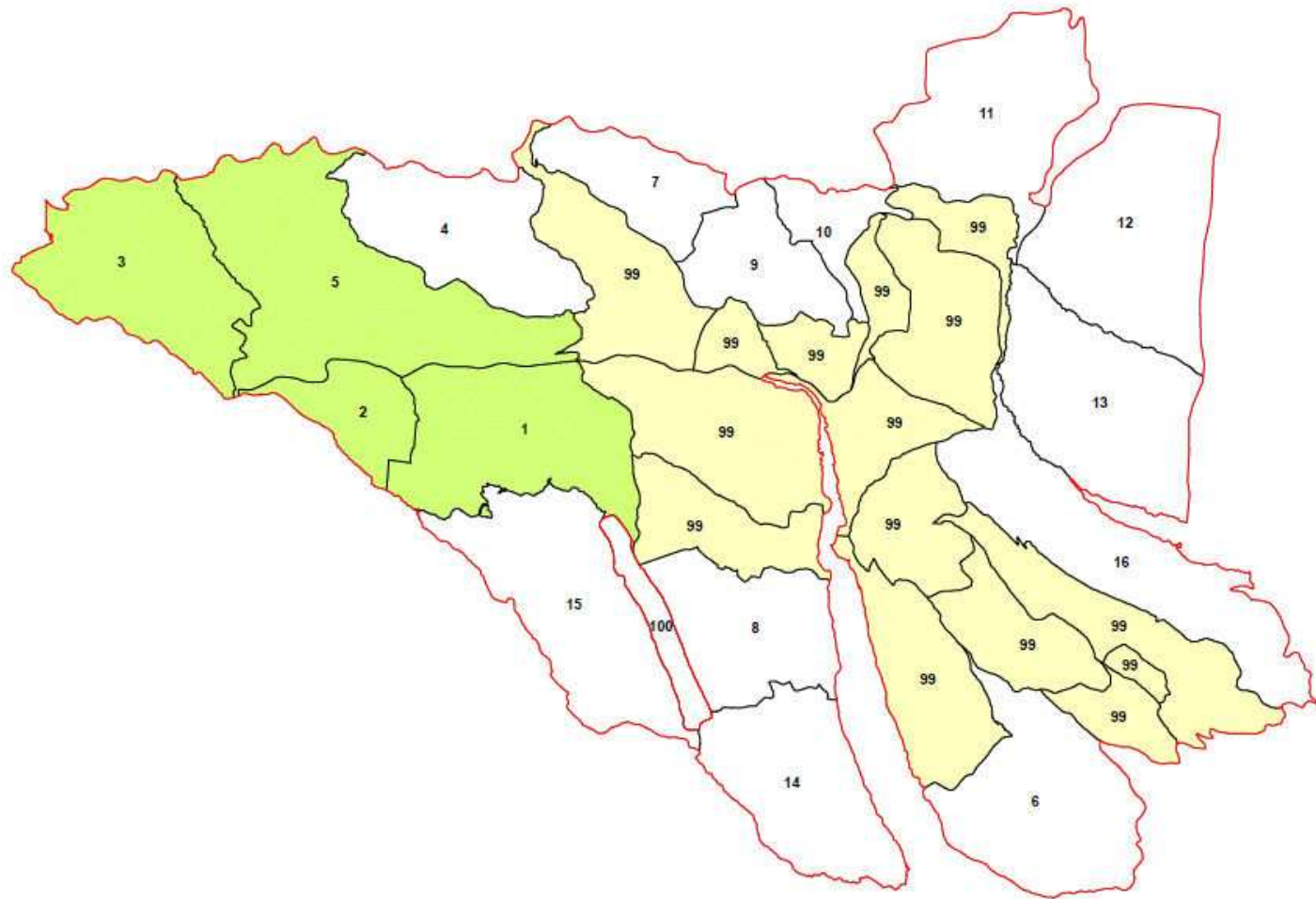
- Fir Beetle under control.
- 34 trap tree sites were felled.
- Only three sites had spill over.

MID-TERM REPORT

- Forest service asks for mid-term report.
- Measure against application, management plan and goals both short and long term.
- Community Support.
- Financially viable operation.
- If we pass they will offer a long term license before the end of the 5 year pilot.
