Forest Investment Account Projects
A new low mobility, wheelchair accessible trail has been completed at Quesnel Forks this fall. The trail skirts along the shore of the Cariboo River and is accessed from the recreation and campsite. It is a wide, packed gravel trail that will add a new dimension to the well used and visited location.

Other Forest Investment Account (FIA) projects this year included recreation site maintenance at Quesnel Forks, and danger tree removal of the Bull Mountain Cross Country ski trails. Our community forest partners at Soda Creek will implement the Bull Mountain project.

Currently, there are other projects proposed, pending funding.


